C.M.T. PRODUCTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Unit: A single garment or product made according to your specifications.

Sample: A garment or product made to your specifications, priced at least twice as much as usual orders due to singular production.

CMT (Cut, Make, Trim): A service where the client provides all materials, trims, and fabrics needed for production.

Client/Customer: The buyer for any CMT service.

Payment Terms: For all samples, full payment is required upfront, and production cannot begin until payment is received. Credit terms for production costs are available: 70% of the cost is required upfront, and 30% upon collection. We accept bank transfers, Sum-up payments, and cheques (cheques incur a 5% processing charge).

Sampling: All new garments or products must be sampled and approved by the customer before production begins. This includes changes to design, label placement, size, detailing, and textiles. Changes to patterns will incur additional fees. Production starts only after final sample approval. Samples are essential to ensure customer satisfaction and become part of the contract. No refunds or remakes are available if dissatisfied with the sample.

Fabric and Trims: Customers must supply all materials, trims, and fabrics for CMT work. A list of required materials must be provided in the technical specifications pack. Materials are checked for quality and quantity upon arrival, and receipt is confirmed with the customer. Production starts only once all materials have arrived. Work stops if wrong, inappropriate, or insufficient materials are supplied. Failure to provide same, will result in delays to agreed timelines and will incur a 10% charge. Agreed delivery dates are renegotiated when all materials are received. Refunds for products not produced due to lack of fabric are considered case-by-case.

NO production will begin if ANY of the aforementioned items are missing.

Contact: Once production commences, you must be available for calls between 8am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. Any production delays with incur a surcharge, i.e. ill-fitting patters pieces, fabric shortages, pattern irregularities etc.

Turnaround Times: Estimate 6-8 weeks for orders. Exact delivery times are agreed upon order placement. Booking early secures a spot in the production run, but exact timing depends on existing bookings.

Postage: Delivery method and costs are clarified at order placement and added to the invoice. Customers may use their own courier. Fashion Connect Ireland is responsible for products only until handed over to the delivery company. International deliveries may be subject to customs clearance, taxes, and import thresholds, which are the customer's responsibility. Customers must update address changes via email.

Packaging: Sustainable, low-waste, and recyclable/compostable packaging is used. Reuse of client-supplied packaging materials is encouraged.

Returns and Assurance of Quality: No refunds for bespoke items once accepted and manufactured. Samples ensure quality, and production adheres to sample standards. In case of substandard quality, products will be replaced at no cost. Cancellations at least 8 working days before production incur no fee. Later cancellations may incur a 20% fee if they cause a gap in the production schedule. Orders started and then cancelled or postponed must be paid in full at.

Faults: Quality control checks are performed before shipping. Report stitching faults within 5 working days for fixes or refunds. Refunds are issued after fault verification. No refunds or repairs will be given if the client has already attempted repairs.

Confidentiality, Intellectual Property, and Storage: Designs and intellectual property are protected. Customer patterns and materials remain the property of the supplier/owner and are not reused. Surplus fabrics and materials are returned to the client after project completion.

Commitment to Originality and Ethical Practices: Fashion Connect Ireland commits to originality and integrity, not replicating commercially available designs. Intellectual property of all designers is respected.

Liability: Liability for defective work is limited to rectification or credit. No liability for indirect or consequential loss, or third-party claims. Faulty work must be replaced by FCI unless the customer can show clear cause for refusal. Choosing third-party rework without consulting FCI voids any remedies from FCI.

Jurisdiction: All agreements are governed by the laws of Ireland, with mediation as the first step in dispute resolution, followed by litigation in the courts of Ireland if necessary.
